2.131(b)(1) Critical

Handling of animals.

A non-human primate suffered a fatal injury while being handled for a medical procedure. On 4/16/25 a female cynomolgus macaque (DB849) evaded 2 animal care technicians and escaped her enclosure. She ran down the central aisle toward an exhaust fan, where she tried to crawl through the open slates and sustained a severe head injury from the moving fan blades. Due to the severe head trauma, the animal was euthanized. Animals that are not handled carefully can become distressed and injured, including death. Handling of all animals shall be done as expeditiously and carefully as possible in a manner that does not cause trauma, overheating, excessive cooling, behavioral stress, physical harm, or unnecessary discomfort. 3.80(a)(2)(ii) Critical

Primary enclosures.

A primary enclosure in the facility did not protect a non-human primate from injury. On 7/10/25, a 16-year-old female Rhesus Macaque (09D128) suffered from a transverse fracture of the tibia and fibula of the right leg and was eventually euthanized on 8/1/25 after it was determined that the fracture was not healing and she would not do well with an amputation. The fracture occurred when she wedged her right leg between the two round bars that make up a perch in the enclosure. The two bars have clamps at regular intervals between the perch mounts to keep the bars aligned across the length of the perch. It was determined that the clamps on the perch were of an older style that created a smaller gap at the clamp point, creating a catch point where the limb became entrapped. All clamps of this style were removed from each enclosure following this incident. Animals who are injured or entangled by their primary enclosure may experience pain, injury, stress, and even death. Correct by ensuring that enclosures protect nonhuman primates from injury. Corrected prior to date of inspection on 4/15/26
